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What skills will I learn?

The program will enhance the apprentice's procurement skills and encourage ethical, future-focused innovation. The apprentice will improve competence in all procurement stages and apply factual, procedural, and theoretical knowledge. Learners will handle well-defined, complex, non-routine tasks, understanding the need for relevant information and its effective interpretation. They will utilise their procurement knowledge and experience to demonstrate how to lead the procurement team while considering the wider supply chain and potential future risks and opportunities.

Assessments
